Wildlife monitoring projects:

Carried out 3 surveys for Brown Hairstreak Butterfly eggs and found in 2 locations a total of 12 eggs





Brown Hairstreak egg (found on survey in parish) develop into these butterflies (image Butterfly Conservation), this is a species that is in decline (and classed as a priority species) due to hedgerow removal and annual flailing so to find them in the parish is good news!
